Appeals Commission

Volume of Appeals

Our volume of new appeals so far this year continues to trend higher than last year.

2024-2025 Fiscal Year (April 1, 2024 – October 31, 2024)	463
2023-2024 Fiscal Year (April 1, 2023 – October 31, 2023)	374

Average Timelines for Notice of Appeal to Hearing

This timeline remains higher than target as a result of an ongoing shortage of Hearing Chairs and an increased number of new appeals. Mitigation efforts are ongoing.
